Bus Atlas UK

This important project plans bus maps covering the whole of the UK, showing principal inter-urban and rural bus services. Its author is Brendan Fox, of Peterborough Bus Times (see below). The first stage will have 40 maps covering England, Wales and Scotland as far north as Stirling. So far 28 maps have been completed. The next stage will add maps for the rest of Scotland and Northern Ireland. This is one of the most exciting developments of the decade, given the demise of so many operator and county maps in recent years.
